## *About Vrithi*

*Vrithi Montessori School was established to provide authentic and affordable Montessori Education. The school provides an environment that supports the natural unfolding of the child's potential. The Montessori Method is a scientific, time tested method that imparts education as an aid to development.*

*We at Vrithi believe that each child is unique, equipped with skills that nature has provided to become a confident, responsible, intelligent, and independent adult who is capable of using knowledge and experiences to make the right choices and decisions in life.*

*We guide and support the learning in a child according to the developmental needs of each age group.*

*We respect the learner in every child.*

## **Age & Classes**

*Our Montessori environments are mixed age group environments.*

### **Primary Environment**

*Children between 2 ½ - 6 ½ years will work with Montessori materials to gain life skills, refine their senses and understand basic concepts of language and mathematics.*

### **Elementary Environment**

*Children between 6 ½ - 11 years will work with Montessori materials to explore concepts in all subject areas and develop social skills.*

## **Curriculum and evaluation**

*The Curriculum followed is the Montessori Curriculum. The requirements of major boards like ICSE, CBSE and NIOS are kept in mind while framing the syllabus. The curriculum is concept based.*

*Evaluation will not be based on standardized tests. However, the progress of the child will be continuously observed and evaluated. This will be shared with parents at the end of each term through term reports. The reports are the unbiased observations of your child's work and progress.*

*\* If your child is observed to have learning/developmental difficulties, you should be willing to take your child for the assessments suggested by the school for the benefit of the child. A true assessment report will have to be submitted to help the school plan effectively for your child.*

## **Homework**

*Age appropriate homework will be given as and when necessary.*

## **Parent School Association**

*It is important for parents and teachers to see the child in the same light for the benefit of the child.*

*Regular open house days are scheduled when parents can meet the teachers.*

*The parents will be invited to meet the teachers at the end of every term to discuss their child's progress.*

*Parent teacher meetings and workshops will be held to help understand the school philosophy and the Montessori Method of education.*

*The school will invite parents to volunteer for helping conduct/ organize various events.*

## **Calendar**

*The academic year is from June to April and is divided into three terms. Each term is followed by a vacation. The school functions from Monday to Friday. The school may work on Saturdays based on need and this will be intimated accordingly.*

## ***School Events***

*Annual Concert, Sports Day and Elementary Open Day will be held once a year. Apart from this various national and cultural festivals will be celebrated in school. An annual medical check-up will be organized once a year. Regular field trips will be scheduled.*

## ***School Uniform***

*Boys : Shirt & Shorts*

*Girls : Blouse & Shorts/ Divided Skirt*

*Boys & Girls : White canvas shoes and white socks*

*There will be a sports uniform (Jersey and Shorts)*

## ***Fees***

*There will be a non-refundable admission fee to be paid at the time of admission.*

*The fee for a term is collected in advance and should be paid on or before the date intimated by the school.*

*Term fee will be revised periodically.*

*Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.*

## ***Admission Procedure***

*The Application Form and Fee Structure will be available after registration.*

*The filled application form has to be submitted within two working days after issue. Once the application form is submitted the admission process will commence. All eligible applications are considered for admission based on available vacancies.*

*The school will schedule the Admission Interview. Both parents with the child/children for whom admission is sought for should be present for the interview. This will last approximately one hour and is a wonderful opportunity to get to know the routines and philosophy of a Montessori School and to understand what to expect of the Montessori experience. You will also get to see the environments.*

*Admission is granted based on the readiness of the child for school and whether the parents' educational philosophy is compatible with that of the school. For children above 5 years there will be an entrance evaluation. Criteria for acceptance will vary by age and may include teacher assessments based on interviews, make-up of current classes and available space.*

*If admission is granted the admission letter will be sent by mail. Once the school receives confirmation by mail and the non-refundable admission fee has been paid on or before the intimated date, the child will be officially enrolled in the school records. At the time of admission, the parents must mention if the child has any learning difficulty / developmental delay, failing which the school reserves every right to cancel the admission.*

*In case a situation arises where the child needs to move out of school, then the school should be informed well in advance in writing. The child will be issued a Bonafide Certificate and their report at the time of leaving school.*
