What is SAIL

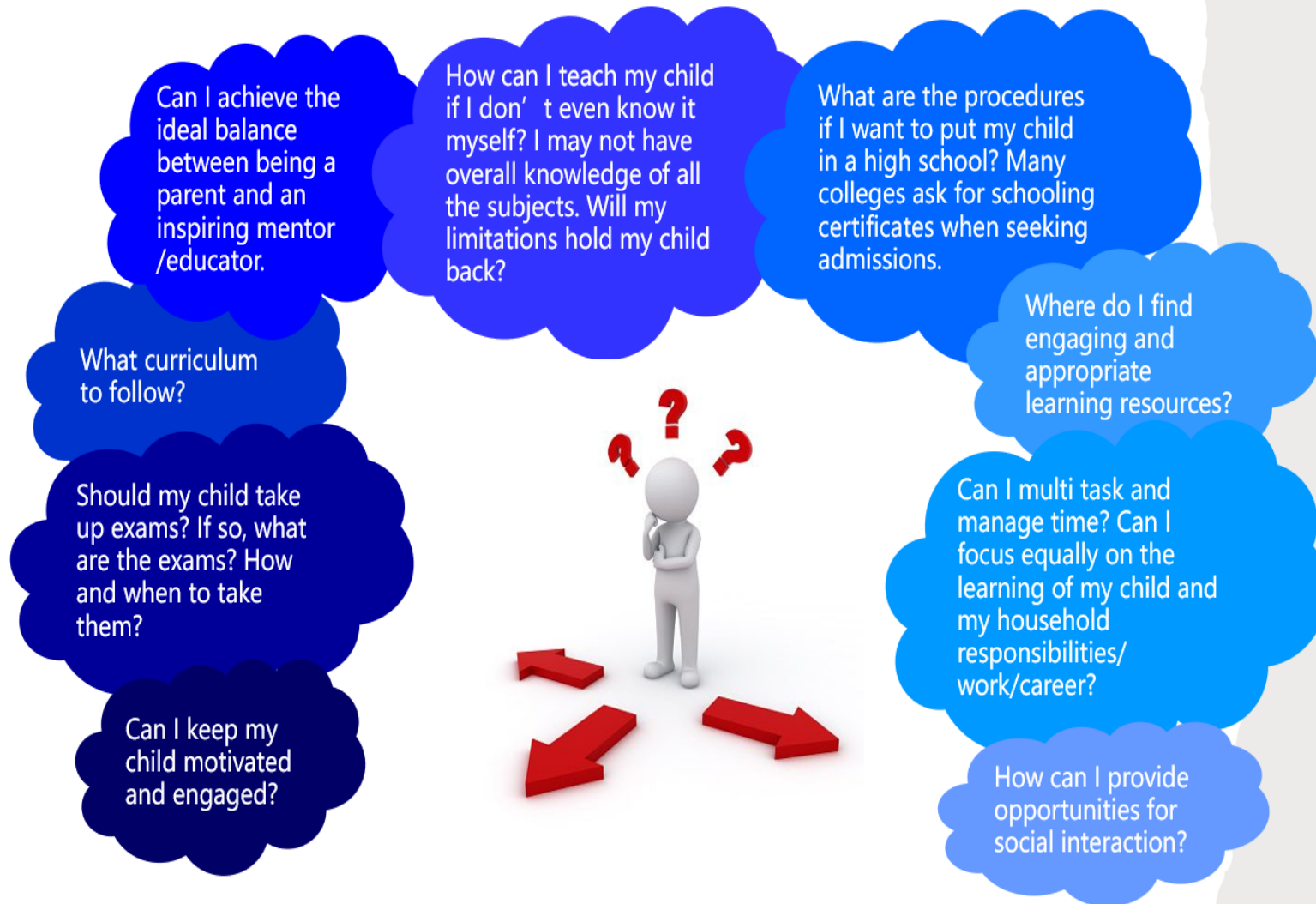


SAIL is a uniquely designed program that satisfies the need for

- SAIL program has been created to support parents who are looking for an extended Montessori approach beyond the Elementary Environment or looking for alternatives to traditional schooling.
